## September 2023 Block of the Month - Option i - Fall Leaf



## Cutting Instructions

Background:

- A - two 5" squares
- B - one $41 / 2$ " square
- C - one 5 " square

Leaf and Stem (various browns,
oranges, golds, etc.):

- D - two 5" squares
- E - three $41 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ squares
- F - one 1" x 8 " rectangle


## Sewing Instructions

1. Draw diagonal lines on the back of the $A$ pieces. Layer the $A$ and $D$ pieces, right sides together, and sew $1 / 4$ " on both sides of the diagonal line. Cut apart on the drawn lines. Open and press. Square each unit to $41 / 2^{\prime \prime}$. (Makes 4 half-square triangles.)
2. Cut the C piece in half diagonally. Gently fold each resulting triangle in half along the longest edge to find the center, and finger press.
3. Fold the F piece in half lengthwise to find the center, and finger press. Matching the centers, sew the $F$ piece to each of the $C$ triangles. Press, and square the unit to $41 / 2^{\prime \prime}$.
4. Arrange the units as shown in the diagram above, and assemble the leaf block.
