Now, how about a block of the month quilt! This one is made exclusively from half square triangles so EVERYONE can do this. Every block is different. Instructions will include a 8 " and a 12 " measurement depending on what size quilt you want to make. You can make it color matched throughout but I thought it might be good scrappy. Here goes! P.S. It was published in a magazine and I purchased the pattern.

Reminder, for 8 " blocks - Make 16 hst's $21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 21 / 2^{\prime \prime}$
for 12 " blocks Make 16 hst's $31 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 31 / 2$ "
Make one of each block below using your desired size of half-square triangles..
