 (Based on 5" squares, 4" per charm pack)
 Quilt sizes do not include borders. Add borders or more squares for drop

| Size | Layout | Finished (inches) | Squares | Charm Packs |
|-------|---------|-------------------|---------|-------------|
| Crib | 6 x 7 | 30 x 35 | 42 | 1 |
| Twin | 8 x 15 | 40 x 75 | 120 | 3 |
| Full | 11 x 15 | 55 x 75 | 165 | 4 |
| Queen | 12 x 16 | 60 x 80 | 192 | 5 |
| King | 16 x 16 | 80 x 80 | 256 | 7 |
| King | 18 x 18 | 80 x 90 | 288 | 7 |

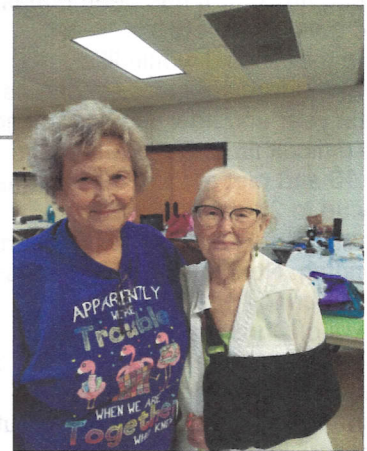
