

Programs – Ann Cosgrove had printed two patterns for ideas for the Christmas 6 ½" block exchange. We can bring up to 12 blocks to exchange at the December meeting. All blocks need to be signed and dated. We will have a potluck at the December Meeting. More information will come in the newsletter.
