
Butterfly Block



Block size: 9" finished (9½" unfinished)

Cutting Instructions

Background:

- A two 41/4" squares
- B four 2" squares
- C two 11/2" squares
- D two 21/4" squares
- E one 1" x 4½" rectangle
- F one 1" x 21/4" rectangle

Top Wings:

• G - two 4¾" x 6" rectangles

Bottom Wings:

• H - two 4" x 43/4" rectangles

Body

• I - one 1" x 3¾" rectangle

Sewing Instructions

- 1. Orient the two G pieces so that they are taller than they are wide. Use the A pieces and two of the B pieces to snowball two corners of each of the G pieces as shown in the diagram. (Be careful with the orientations.)
- 2. Orient the two H pieces so that they are wider than they are tall. Use the remaining B pieces and the C and D pieces to snowball the H pieces as shown in the diagram. (Be careful with the orientations.)
- 3. Sew together the two left wing pieces. Sew together the two right wing pieces.
- 4. Sew together the E, I, and F pieces as shown in the diagram.
- 5. Sew the left and right wing units from step 3 to the body unit from step 4.

Suggestion: Consider pressing your seams open, especially where snowballed pieces meet each other or the body piece. Having the seams pressed open will make it easier to match the seams.

Note: Measure your completed block. If it is more than ½" undersized, please try to rework to correct the size. If the block is slightly oversized, please <u>do not trim</u>. (It will be trimmed as needed at the next step.)
