Quilt Entry Rules:

- 1. The completed Registration Form must be received **no later than July 10** by Spinning Spools Quilt Guild (SSQG). No entry will be accepted after this date without consent of the Registration Coordinator. Please enter early, as the number of entries accepted is limited to space available. You will be notified by email when your entry is received.
- 2. There is no entry fee for SSQG members. Fee for non-SSQG members (per quilt) is \$10 for show only or \$20 to be judged. Make checks payable to Spinning Spools Quilt Guild, and include payment when delivering the quilt.
- 3. Quilts entered in previous SSQG shows are not eligible to enter again.
- 4. An entrant must have approval from the Quilt Show Committee to enter more than two quilts in a single judged category. An entrant can enter quilts in different categories.
- 5. Each entry must be **clean and free of smoke, odor, insects, and pet hair**.
- 6. Each entry must have a fabric identification label sewn securely to the back of the quilt or the Exhibitor's name written on the quilt to ensure the quilt will be returned to the correct individual. A hanging sleeve is <u>not</u> required.
- 7. Each entry must be delivered in a bag or pillowcase that completely encloses the quilt. Pillowcases or fabric bags are preferred. Bags or pillowcases must be marked with the entrant's name.
- 8. The Quilt Show Committee reserves the right to make the final decision if a quilt does not meet entry rules and requirements.
- 9. Entries must be **delivered** to the Pottawatomie County Museum, 207 N Minnesota Ave, Shawnee, OK on **Saturday, July 19 between noon and 4 pm**. You will be given a pickup ticket when you deliver your quilt.
- After the show, all entries must be picked up at the Geiger Center, Oklahoma Baptist University, Shawnee, OK by the Exhibitor or a designated person on Saturday, August 9 between 5 and 6 pm. You must have the pick-up ticket in order to pick up entries.
- 11. SSQG will not be responsible for any quilts not picked up.

Agreement Statement: I hereby agree to permit the Spinning Spools Quilt Guild to display my quilt during the 2025 Quilt Show. I understand that no responsibility for loss of or damage to my quilt is assumed by Spinning Spools Quilt Guild, by any of the members, or by Oklahoma Baptist University. I also agree that any visitor, news media person, and/or member may photograph my quilt entry while it is displayed in the quilt show; however, any use of said photograph for commercial or personal profit must have my written permission.
