
Snowball Flower Block



Block size: 9" finished (9½" unfinished)

Cutting Instructions

Flower:

• A - four 5" squares

Background:

• B - twelve 11/2" squares

Yellow Center:

• C - four 1½" squares

Sewing Instructions

- 1. For each A piece, use three B pieces and one C piece to snowball all four corners.
- 2. Arrange the four snowballed units from step 1 with the yellow centers together, as shown in the diagram. Sew together like a four-patch, trying to match all corners.

Suggestion: Consider pressing your seams open, especially where snowballed pieces meet each other. Having the seams pressed open will make it easier to match the seams.

Note: Measure your completed block. If it is more than $\frac{1}{8}$ " undersized, please try to rework to correct the size. If the block is slightly oversized, please <u>do not trim</u>. (It will be trimmed as needed at the next step.)
